

Snow To Sea Winter Retreat

Trip Requirements (Packet Due January 20th 2019)

January 24th-26th 2019

Purpose For the Trip: This trip is designed to be a reward trip for students who put in the time and effort to meet the requirements. Also this trip will be a great time of fellowship where we will grow closer to God and to each other. On the trip we will go sledding in the snow, and shop and play at the coast. We will also spend some time worshipping, reading God's word, and praying.

Cost: The rental vans and gas will be provided free of charge by the church. We will also be staying in locations that are free of charge to keep the cost down.

Cost = \$20 Due January 20th

Bring = \$10-15 (For two fast food meals)

Your Choice = \$ for Dutch Bros or shopping, etc.

Requirements

- **Attendance:** Between November 20th and January 20th there are 16 opportunities to go to Sunday morning church or Wednesday night youth. You need to go to 10 of the 16. (There are 10 Sundays and 6 Wednesdays)
- **Bible Verses:** Before January 20th you will need to say all three of the required memory verses with their references. The verses will need to be memorized in the NIV version of the bible.
- **Invite Friends to Church:** Over the next two months you will need to invite at least 3 friends to come with you to any church event. They do not need to come, but if they don't come you still need to make documentation of when and how you invited them.

- **Service Project:** You can do any community service project that you would like. You will need to write up a description of what you did and how it helped people. Minimum requirement is 2 hours.
- **Having Snow Gear:** Since we are going to the snow one of the requirements is that you have the proper snow gear. Snow pants, Gloves/mittens, jacket, warm socks, extra pair of shoes preferably boots, and beanie/something that covers your head/ears.
- **Showering at least once on the trip:** No offense but middle school and high school students who don't shower stink. It is a requirement that you shower at least once on the trip. Make sure to bring a towel and soap.
